Title: AN ACT PROHIBITING THE USE OF A CERTAIN APPLICATION, SOFTWARE AND PROGRAMS ON STATE GOVERNMENT DEVICES AND REQUIRING MINIMUM SECURITY STANDARDS AND ANNUAL AUDITS OF SUCH DEVICES.

Statement of Purpose: To prohibit the download or use of TikTok or other programs, software or devices determined to be a cyber security threat on state government devices, to require the development of minimum security standards to apply across state government and to require annual audits of such devices to ensure they comply with such minimum security standards.
