OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Revenue Gain

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact, resulting in the fiscal impact described below.

The amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP), by January 1, 2025, to produce a Connecticut Decarbonization Roadmap, which has no fiscal impact since the agency has the necessary expertise. It also requires DEEP to identify additional federal funds available to municipalities and schools for reducing carbon emissions. This could result in a revenue gain to various municipalities and schools beginning in FY 24 to the extent federal funds are made available following such identification.
