OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment, which specifies that the provisions of the bill be implemented within available appropriations, does not alter the fiscal impact as identified in the underlying fiscal note. The provision that each birth hospital must provide educational materials developed by maternal mortality review committee to each postpartum patient, on and after 1/1/24, is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
