No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the language of the underlying bill, replacing it with language that requires birthing hospitals, on and after 2/1/24, to provide postpartum patients with educational materials on intimate partner violence, developed by the maternal mortality review committee, is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
