OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Revenue Loss

The amendment establishes reciprocal privileges to certain out of state firearms permit holders, resulting in a potential revenue loss to the state and municipalities to the extent that these individuals no longer apply for state firearms permits.

The amendment also requires, by January 1, 2024, and annually thereafter, the Office of the Attorney General (OAG) to shall publish on the agency's website, a list of any state that issues a permit or license to carry a gun with similar standards as required by under the bill. Additionally, it requires OAG to negotiate and enter into agreements with the appropriate states to grant reciprocal privileges to carry a gun to anyone with a permit or license to carry, under certain conditions. This is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact as OAG currently has the staff capacity and expertise for these purposes.
