Potential Revenue Gain

The amendment expands situations where a third violation may be issued for violation of municipal blight regulation. As the bill allows a higher penalty for third (or more) violations, this may result in a potential revenue gain for municipalities, beginning in FY 24, that is dependent on the number and type of blight violations that occur along with the penalty levels chosen by municipalities.
