The amendment reduces the maximum daily civil penalties municipalities can impose for blight from (1) \$150 to \$100 for occupied property, (2) \$250 to \$150 for vacant property and (3) \$1,000 to \$250 for any property if it is a third or subsequent violation occurring within a 12-month period. The results in a decrease in the potential revenue gain associated with the underlying bill.
