OFA Fiscal Note

Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment removes the section of the bill that expands victim notification thereby resulting in a reduction in cost to the bill. This removes the cost of \$835,000 in FY 24 and \$1,105,000 in FY 25 to the Judicial Department and the cost of \$330,000 in FY 24 and \$451,000 in FY 25 to the State Comptroller for fringe benefits.
