OFA Fiscal Note

Potential Savings

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact. The amendment potentially broadens parole eligibility for certain offenders who were under 21 years of age when they committed a crime resulting in a potential marginal savings to the Department of Correction to the extent that additional inmates are granted parole.
