See Fiscal Note Details

The amendment removes the requirement to use project labor agreements for Public Schools Solar Power Systems and Energy Efficiency Projects Loan Program projects that cost more than ten million dollars. This may result in either different costs for future eligible projects, dependent on the terms of such agreements, or in additional projects being eligible for financing through the program. Either change may alter the rate at which the pool of funds is awarded without changing the overall cost to the state. Project costs may be different for local and regional school districts, along with unknown changes to the specific districts receiving financing under the Public Schools Solar Power Systems and Energy Efficiency Projects Loan Program.
