Explanation

The amendment creates a new a Class D misdemeanor for giving a fish as a prize. This results in a potential cost to the Judicial Department and a potential revenue gain from fines. On average, the marginal cost for supervision in the community is less than \$800¹ each year.

¹ Probation marginal cost is based on services provided by private providers and only includes costs that increase with each additional participant. This does not include a cost for additional supervision by a probation officer unless a new offense is anticipated to result in enough additional offenders to require additional probation officers.
