The amendment strikes the section requiring municipalities to provide housing code violation complaint forms in English and Spanish, and its associated fiscal impact, which is a potential minimal cost to municipalities of less than \$5,000.

Instead, the amendment requires the Department of Housing (DOH) to develop and translate into Spanish, the housing code violation complaint forms that must be provided by the municipalities. This results in a minimal cost of less than \$1,000 to DOH for translation services, and a potential minimal cost to municipalities associated with printing the forms.
