OFA Fiscal Note

Significant Cost

The amendment, which requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to process applications for facilities under the bill's provisions within six months, would result in significant annual costs to DEEP beginning in FY 24. These costs are associated with additional staffing resources required to process applications by the amendment's timeframe, which is substantially shorter than typically occurs.
