3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2023*) There shall be within the  
6 Department of Aging and Disability Services a dementia services  
7 coordinator. The dementia services coordinator shall (1) coordinate  
8 dementia services across state agencies, (2) assess and analyze  
9 dementia-related data collected by the state, (3) evaluate state-funded  
10 dementia services, (4) identify and support the development of  
11 dementia-specific training programs, and (5) perform any other relevant  
12 duties to support individuals with dementia in the state, as determined  
13 by the Commissioner of Aging and Disability Services."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
