"AN ACT CONCERNING THE HOUSING TRUST FUND."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 8-336q of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*
5 *1, 2023*):

6 (b) There shall be a Housing Trust Fund Program Advisory
7 Committee. Said committee shall meet at least [semiannually] monthly
8 and shall advise the commissioner on (1) the administration,
9 management and objectives of the Housing Trust Fund program; and
10 (2) the development of regulations, procedures and rating criteria for
11 the program. The committee shall be appointed by the commissioner, in
12 consultation with the Treasurer and the secretary, and shall include the
13 chairpersons and ranking members of the joint standing committee of
14 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to planning
15 and development, and the joint standing committee of the General
16 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to housing and

17 representatives from each of the following: (A) The nonprofit housing
18 development community; (B) the for-profit housing development
19 community; (C) a housing authority; (D) a community development
20 financial institution; (E) the Connecticut Housing Finance Authority; (F)
21 a state-wide housing organization; (G) an elected or appointed official
22 of a municipality with a population of less than fifty thousand; (H) an
23 elected or appointed official of a municipality with a population
24 between fifty thousand and one hundred thousand; (I) an elected or
25 appointed official of a municipality with a population in excess of one
26 hundred thousand; and (J) the employers of the state, which may be
27 satisfied by the appointment of a representative from a state business
28 and industry association or regional chambers of commerce."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
