**"RESOLUTION APPROVING A STATE CONSTITUTIONAL
AMENDMENT TO ALLOW NO-EXCUSE ABSENTEE VOTING."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. That the following be proposed as an amendment to the
4 Constitution of the State, which, when approved and adopted in the
5 manner provided by the Constitution, shall, to all intents and purposes,
6 become a part thereof:

7 Article sixth of the Constitution is amended by adding section 12 as
8 follows:

9 Sec. 12. At least annually, the secretary of the state shall examine the
10 records of all electors in the state to ensure the accuracy thereof,
11 including verification of United States citizenship and removal of
12 registrations in more than one town, of multiple registrations in the
13 same town and of registrations for individuals who are deceased.

14 RESOLVED: That the foregoing proposed amendment to the
15 Constitution be continued to the next session of the General Assembly
16 elected at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024, and
17 published with the laws passed at the present session, or be presented
18 to the electors at the general election to be held on November 5, 2024,
19 whichever the case may be, according to article sixth of the amendments
20 to the Constitution. The designation of said proposed amendment to be
21 used on the ballots at such election shall be "Shall the Constitution of the
22 State be amended to require annual audits of the state-wide voter
23 rolls?"
