**"AN ACT CONCERNING COMPASSIONATE OR MEDICAL PAROLE  
AND CREDITS AWARDED FOR RELEASE DURING AN  
EMERGENCY DECLARATION AND SENTENCE COMMUTATIONS  
BY THE BOARD OF PARDONS AND PAROLES."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 18-98e of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October*  
5 *1, 2023*):

6 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, any person  
7 sentenced to a term of imprisonment for a crime committed on or after  
8 October 1, 1994, and committed to the custody of the Commissioner of  
9 Correction on or after said date, except a person sentenced for a  
10 violation of section 53a-54a, 53a-54b, 53a-54c, 53a-54d, 53a-55, 53a-55a,  
11 53a-70a, 53a-70c, [or] 53a-92, 53a-92a, 53a-100aa, 53a-192a, or 53a-196a  
12 or is a persistent dangerous felony offender or persistent dangerous  
13 sexual offender pursuant to section 53a-40, may be eligible to earn risk

14 reduction credit toward a reduction of such person's sentence, in an  
15 amount not to exceed five days per month, at the discretion of the  
16 Commissioner of Correction for conduct as provided in subsection (b)  
17 of this section occurring on or after April 1, 2006."
