1 After line 505, insert the following:

2 "(m) No applicant who receives a sentence commutation in excess of
3 fifteen years from a sentence for a violation of section 53a-54a, 53a-54b,
4 53a-54d, 53a-70a, 53a-70c, 53a-92, 53a-92a, 53a-192a, 53a-196a or 53a-
5 100aa of the general statutes, shall be allowed to go at large unless such
6 commutation is subsequently approved by the Governor and results in
7 the inmate being released within eighteen months of the commutation,
8 and such commutation is conditioned upon the applicant being
9 monitored by a global positioning system device for one year."
