1 After line 394, insert the following:

2 "(8) Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, no proposed
3 commutation for an applicant serving a sentence for a conviction for a
4 violation of section 53a-54a, 53a-54b, 53a-54d, 53a-70a, 53a-70c, 53a-92,
5 53a-92a, 53a-192a, 53a-196a, or 53a-100aa of the general statutes may be
6 finalized unless approved by the Governor. The board shall transmit
7 any such proposed commutation, the application for such commutation
8 and all other documentation or other evidence considered by a
9 commutations panel when formulating its decision to approve the
10 application. Not later than forty-five days after receipt of such proposed
11 commutation, application, documentation and evidence, the Governor
12 shall approve or deny such commutation and notify, in writing, the
13 board and the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
14 cognizance of matters relating to the judiciary of such approval or

15 denial."
