16 Court Support Services Division of the Judicial Branch, and (vi) the
17 Office of the Division of Criminal Justice, of any determination made by
18 the board or commutations panel concerning suspension or revocation
19 pursuant to this subsection, which shall include the decision of the
20 board or panel, any reason for the decision and the weight the board or
21 panel assigned to relevant information in the record when rendering its
22 decision."
