**"AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE JUSTICE."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 53a-225 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):

5 (a) For purposes of this section, "criminal act" means criminal act, as  
6 defined in section 53a-224.

7 (b) A person is guilty of enticing a juvenile to commit a criminal act  
8 if such person is [twenty-three] eighteen years of age or older and  
9 knowingly causes, encourages, solicits, recruits, intimidates or coerces a  
10 person under eighteen years of age to commit or participate in the  
11 commission of a criminal act.

12 (c) Enticing a juvenile to commit a criminal act is a (1) class [A  
13 misdemeanor] D felony for a first offense, and (2) class [D] C felony for  
14 any subsequent offense."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
