**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE PROGRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION."**

1 Strike subsection (f) in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "(f) The Commissioner of Energy and Environmental Protection shall  
4 adopt regulations, in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54, as  
5 are necessary and proper to carry out the purposes of this section. The  
6 provisions of subsection (g) of this section shall not take effect until the  
7 adoption of the regulations pursuant to this subsection. Such  
8 regulations shall include, but need not be limited to, provisions  
9 regarding: (1) Procedures and requirements for creating the meaningful  
10 public participation plan and the public participation report required by  
11 this section; (2) the identification and measurement of the relative  
12 impact of environmental and public health stressors across  
13 communities; (3) tools for stakeholder industries and sectors to use that

14 take account of any such environmental or public health stressors,  
15 including tools to help inform decisions about potential locations for  
16 proposed affecting facilities that comply with the provisions of this  
17 section; and (4) standards for denying or placing conditions on permits.  
18 The commissioner shall consult with stakeholder industries and sectors  
19 when developing the regulations pursuant to this section. The  
20 legislative body of any municipality may vote to opt out of the  
21 application of such regulations for any affecting facility proposed for  
22 such municipality."
