**"AN ACT CONCERNING JUVENILE JUSTICE."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 53a-212 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2023*):

5 (a) A person is guilty of stealing a firearm when, with intent to  
6 deprive another person of such other person's firearm or to appropriate  
7 the firearm to such person or a third party, such person wrongfully  
8 takes, obtains or withholds a firearm, as defined in subdivision (19) of  
9 section 53a-3.

10 (b) Stealing a firearm is a class [C] B felony for which two years of the  
11 sentence imposed may not be suspended or reduced by the court, and  
12 five thousand dollars of the fine imposed may not be remitted or  
13 reduced by the court unless the court states on the record its reasons for

14 remitting or reducing such fine."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
