Explanation

The bill allows nonconforming vehicle permits to be issued for an additional vehicle type. To the extent the permits are issued, this is expected to result in a revenue gain to the Special Transportation fund.

Senate "A" eliminates the original bill and its associated fiscal impact, and results in the impact described above.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to the number of permits issued.
