Explanation

The bill results in potential costs to local and regional school districts annually beginning in FY 25 if the towns of which they are comprised choose to compensate board of education members beyond the secretary. Any cost to a local or regional school district will depend on the compensation determined by the town (or towns, in the case of a regional school district).

Senate "A" allows the town, rather than the board of education, to determine compensation for members of the board of education.

The Out Years

The annualized ongoing fiscal impact identified above would continue into the future subject to any changes in compensation set by boards of education.
