AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR A GRANT-IN-AID TO SOUTH CENTRAL CHIEFS OF POLICE ASSOCIATION, INC. FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN TRACKING TECHNOLOGY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That the sum of five hundred thousand dollars be allocated from
2 federal funds available under section 602 of Subtitle M of Title IX of the
3 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, P.L. 117-2, for the fiscal year ending
4 June 30, 2025, to the Department of Emergency Services and Public
5 Protection for a grant-in-aid to South Central Chiefs of Police
6 Association, Inc. to permit said association to offer grants to municipal
7 police departments in the south central region of the state to cover fifty
8 per cent of the cost of acquiring StarChase or similar technology for
9 tracking car thieves and thieves using stolen cars to commit other
10 crimes.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide funding to municipal police departments in the south central region of the state to cover fifty per cent of the cost of acquiring certain technology to track cars.
