**"AN ACT MAKING CHANGES TO AND REPEALING OBSOLETE PROVISIONS OF STATUTES RELEVANT TO THE LABOR DEPARTMENT."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 31-69a of the 2024 supplement to  
4 the general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
5 thereof (*Effective January 1, 2025*):

6 (a) In addition to the penalties provided in this chapter and chapter  
7 568, any employer, officer, agent or other person who violates any  
8 provision of this chapter, chapter 557 or subsection (g) of section 31-288  
9 shall be liable to the Labor Department for a civil penalty of three  
10 hundred dollars for each violation of said chapters and for each  
11 violation of subsection (g) of section 31-288, except that (1) any person  
12 who violates (A) a stop work order issued pursuant to subsection (c) of  
13 section 31-76a, as amended by this act, shall be liable to the Labor  
14 Department for a civil penalty of five thousand dollars and each day of

15 such violation shall constitute a separate offense, and (B) any provision  
 16 of [section] sections 31-12 [, 31-13 or] to 31-14, inclusive, subsection (a)  
 17 of section 31-15 or section 31-18, 31-23 or 31-24 shall be liable to the  
 18 Labor Department for a civil penalty of six hundred dollars for each  
 19 violation of said sections, [and] (2) a violation of subsection (g) of section  
 20 31-288 shall constitute a separate offense for each day of such violation,  
 21 and (3) any employer that violates the provisions of sections 31-57s to  
 22 31-57u, inclusive, or section 31-57w shall be liable to the Labor  
 23 Department in accordance with the provisions of sections 31-57v and  
 24 31-57w."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
