**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMISSION OF STATE RESIDENTS
TO VETERINARY SCHOOLS."**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2024*) The University of Connecticut shall
4 assess the feasibility of restarting the Kirklyn M. Kerr program,
5 established pursuant to section 10a-19h of the general statutes, with a
6 school of veterinary medicine that is accredited by the American
7 Veterinary Medical Association. Not later than January 1, 2025, The
8 University of Connecticut shall submit, in accordance with the
9 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
10 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
11 relating to higher education and employment advancement and
12 appropriations and the budgets of state agencies a report on the
13 feasibility and cost of restarting said program."
