Title: AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO VARIOUS LAWS CONCERNING IGNITION INTERLOCK DEVICES, THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION, JUDICIAL RETIREMENT SALARIES AND CRIMINAL LAW AND CRIMINAL PROCEDURE.

Statement of Purpose: To revise provisions concerning (1) juror compensation, (2) risk protection orders or warrants, (3) a supervised diversionary program for persons with intellectual disabilities or autism spectrum disorder, (4) the use of ignition interlock devices, (5) the jurisdiction for offenses committed by means of transmitted communications, (6) compensation for persons who are incarcerated, (7) bail payments, (8) competency to stand trial, and (9) credit for time served under house arrest.
