Explanation

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact.

The amendment results in a potential cost to local and regional school districts by eliminating the option for districts to form subcommittees to conduct termination hearings. By doing so, the amendment is anticipated to increase the number of hearing officers that must be hired to conduct such hearings. Any impact to a district will depend on the number of termination hearings that occur and the per-hearing cost of a hearing officer.

The amendment makes other changes regarding the process for terminating tenured teachers. These changes have no fiscal impact as they are not anticipated to affect the cost of any termination proceedings.
