No Fiscal Impact

The amendment, which strikes the language of the underlying bill, replacing it with language allowing podiatrists to perform Chopart joint-level amputations and total ankle replacement surgeries under certain conditions, and requiring the Public Health Committee to convene a panel, is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.
