OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Fiscal Impact in Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill, eliminating its associated fiscal impacts to the state and municipalities.

The amendment requires the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection (DEEP) to complete a study of the state's renewable energy portfolio standard, which has no fiscal impact. The department has sufficient expertise to complete the study.
