No Fiscal Impact

The amendment (1) eliminates an interagency management committee for services to persons with disabilities, (2) changes certain reporting requirements for the Departments of Developmental Services (DDS) and Social Services (DSS), and (3) establishes an interagency coalition to work on strategies to reduce silos in the provision of services for persons with an intellectual or developmental disability or autism spectrum disorder. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact to the state as the agencies have the expertise necessary to meet the requirements of the amendment.
