OFA Fiscal Note

Eliminates Cost In Bill

The amendment strikes the underlying bill and its associated fiscal impact and results in the impact described below.

The amendment (1) establishes a Division of Fire Services Administration to succeed the Office of State Fire Administration, (2) expands the statutory responsibilities of the division, (3) changes the membership of the Commission on Fire Prevention and Control, (4) updates the commission's statutory responsibilities, (5) establishes a working group to make recommendations regarding the structure and operations of the Office of State Fire Marshal and the Office of Education and Data Management within the Department of Administrative Services, and (6) makes various other conforming and procedural changes, all of which result in no fiscal impact to the state or municipalities.

The preceding Fiscal Impact statement is prepared for the benefit of the members of the General Assembly, solely for the purposes of information, summarization and explanation and does not represent the intent of the General Assembly or either chamber thereof for any purpose. In general, fiscal impacts are based upon a variety of informational sources, including the analyst's professional knowledge.
