Reduces Cost In Bill

The amendment, which removes the section that makes changes to juror compensation and reimbursement, reduces the cost in the bill. The amendment removes the cost of \$1.3 million - \$2.25 million in FY 25 and \$2 million - \$3 million in FY 26 to the Judicial Department.
