No Fiscal Impact

The amendment requires colleges and universities to provide either: (1) a statement regarding admissions practices, which may involve a procedural change, or (2) a report with various admissions and enrollment data. This is not anticipated to result in a fiscal impact as public institutions of higher education have the staff and expertise necessary to complete the requirements.
