OFA Fiscal Note

No Fiscal Impact

The amendment strikes the language in the underlying bill and the associated fiscal impact.

The amendment, which results in no fiscal impact, makes various changes affecting the regulation of youth camps, including: 1) establishes a timeline for youth camp inspections and re-inspections when a corrective action plan has been approved; 2) establishes a Youth Camp Safety Advisory Council; and 3) authorizes the Office of Early Childhood to take disciplinary action (e.g., license refusal, suspension, or revocation) against a youth camp licensee if the operator or employee held a youth camp license in another state that was revoked.
