"AN ACT CONCERNING YOUTH CAMPS."

1 Strike section 3 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2024*) On and after July 1, 2024, the
3 owner or operator of an unlicensed youth camp, or the owner or
4 operator's designee, shall report to the Office of Early Childhood any (1)
5 fatality to a camper or staff that occurs at such unlicensed youth camp
6 or results during or from camping activities provided or sponsored by
7 such unlicensed youth camp, or (2) injury that occurs at an unlicensed
8 youth camp or results during or from camping activities provided or
9 sponsored by such unlicensed youth camp and results in a camper being
10 admitted to a hospital or diagnosed with a fracture, concussion or
11 second or third degree burn. Such owner or operator, or such owner or
12 operator's designee, shall submit such report to the office not later than
13 the next business day and such report shall be in writing on a form
14 developed and made available by the office."
