"AN ACT CONCERNING MODIFICATIONS TO THE RENEWABLE PORTFOLIO STANDARD."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Energy and
4 Environmental Protection shall study the risks posed by the impacts of
5 climate change, including flooding and extreme weather events, to
6 nuclear power generating facilities in the state. Such study shall include,
7 but need not be limited to: (1) An evaluation of how flooding and
8 extreme weather events could impact nuclear power generating
9 facilities in the state; and (2) an examination of whether nuclear power
10 generating facilities have adequate measures in place to safeguard
11 against such flooding, extreme weather events and other risks. Not later
12 than January 1, 2025, the commissioner shall report, in accordance with
13 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, the results of the
14 study, to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
15 cognizance of matters relating to energy and technology."
