"AN ACT IMPLEMENTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 14-11e of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1, 2024*):

5 On or before February 1, [2023] 2025, and annually thereafter, the
6 Commissioner of Motor Vehicles shall submit a report, in accordance
7 with the provisions of section 11-4a, to the joint standing committee of
8 the General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
9 transportation. Such annual report shall include the following
10 information from the preceding year: (1) The average amount of time a
11 person spends at the Department of Motor Vehicles for an appointment
12 that was scheduled on the department's Internet web site, (2) the
13 average number of days between the day a person schedules an in-
14 person appointment at the main office or a branch office of the
15 department on the department's Internet web site and the date of such

16 appointment, (3) a list of the transactions that were available to be
 17 conducted by scheduling an appointment on the department's Internet
 18 web site, ~~[(3)]~~ (4) a list of the transactions that were available to be
 19 conducted on the department's Internet web site, ~~[(4)]~~ (5) the number of
 20 transactions conducted on the department's Internet web site, and ~~[(5)]~~
 21 (6) a summary of the department's efforts to increase the types of
 22 transactions available to be conducted on the department's Internet web
 23 site.

24 Sec. 502. Subsection (b) of section 14-12 of the general statutes is
 25 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*
 26 *2024*):

27 (b) (1) To obtain a motor vehicle registration, except as provided in
 28 subsection (c) of this section, the owner shall submit to the
 29 commissioner an application signed by such owner and containing such
 30 information and proof of ownership as the commissioner may require.
 31 The application shall be made in such form and contain such provisions
 32 and information as the commissioner may determine.

33 (2) The commissioner shall permit any person, except a motor vehicle
 34 dealer licensed under the provisions of section 14-52, to register a motor
 35 vehicle at the main office and any branch office of the department
 36 during regular business hours without requiring such person to
 37 schedule an appointment with the department to conduct such
 38 registration."
