1 Strike section 32 in its entirety and renumber the remaining sections
2 and internal references accordingly

3 Strike section 33 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

4 "Sec. 33. (*Effective from passage*) The Office of Health Strategy shall
5 study the impact of allowing a clinical peer, as defined in section 38a-
6 591a of the general statutes, to reverse an adverse determination, as
7 defined in said section, including, but not limited to, the impact on the
8 number of insurance claims and cost of insurance premiums. Not later
9 than January 1, 2025, the executive director of the office shall report, in
10 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
11 to the joint standing committee of the General Assembly having
12 cognizance of matters relating to public health regarding the findings of
13 such study."
