AN ACT CONCERNING THE QUALITY AND DELIVERY OF SPECIAL EDUCATION SERVICES IN CONNECTICUT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Commissioner of Education
2 shall conduct a study about special education in the state. Not later than
3 May 20, 2025, the commissioner shall submit a report of the results of
4 such study to the select committee of the General Assembly having
5 cognizance of matters relating to special education, in accordance with
6 the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
