AN ACT CONCERNING A PERSONAL INCOME TAX CREDIT FOR CERTAIN COLLEGE GRADUATES WITH STEM DEGREES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to reestablish a credit, repealed
- 2 by public act 19-117, against the personal income tax for certain college
- 3 graduates who receive a degree in a science, technology, engineering or
- 4 math-related field.
