AN ACT CONCERNING INCREASED ACCESS TO FREE SCHOOL MEALS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-215 of the general statutes be amended to expand free
- 2 school meals to any student who is a resident of a town in which the
- 3 school district is under the federal Community Eligibility Provision or
- 4 would otherwise be enrolled in a school under the Community
- 5 Eligibility Provision, but such student is enrolled in a school in another
- 6 school district that is not under the Community Eligibility Provision.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure that all students, regardless of which school they are enrolled, have access to free school meals in order to support the health and well-being of children from low-income families.
