AN ACT CONCERNING TERMINOLOGY USED IN THE CONNECTICUT PARENTAGE ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 818 of the general statutes, also known as the
- 2 Connecticut Parentage Act, be amended to replace the terms "person
- 3 who gave birth", "person giving birth", "person who gives birth" and any
- 4 other references to the birthing parent in said chapter with the term
- 5 "mother".

Statement of Purpose:

To protect the rights of women by requiring the use of the word "mother" in the Connecticut Parentage Act.
