AN ACT CONCERNING SOLAR LEASING AND FINANCE COMPANIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require each solar leasing or
- 2 finance company doing business in this state to (1) provide payoff or
- 3 transfer paperwork to a consumer not later than seven days after the
- 4 consumer requests such paperwork, and (2) provide to the consumer a
- 5 rebate in the amount of two hundred fifty dollars if such company fails
- 6 to timely provide such paperwork to the consumer.

Statement of Purpose:

To require each solar leasing or finance company doing business in this state to (1) provide payoff or transfer paperwork to a consumer not later than seven days after the consumer requests such paperwork, and (2) provide to the consumer a rebate in the amount of two- hundred fifty dollars if such company fails to timely provide such paperwork to the consumer.
