AN ACT CONCERNING SPECIAL EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (4) of section 10-76a of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective July 1,*
3 *2025*):

4 (4) "Special education" means specially designed instruction
5 developed in accordance with the regulations of the commissioner,
6 subject to approval by the State Board of Education, offered at no cost to
7 parents or guardians, to meet the unique needs of a child with a
8 disability, including instruction conducted in the classroom, in the
9 home, in hospitals and institutions, and in other settings and instruction
10 in physical education and special classes, programs or services,
11 including related services, designed to meet the educational needs of
12 exceptional children.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
