**AN ACT PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, DISTRIBUTION,
DELIVERY OR SALE OF FOODS CONTAINING CERTAIN ADDITIVES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 417 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 no person doing business in this state shall manufacture, distribute,
- 3 deliver or sell any food if such food (1) is intended for human
- 4 consumption, and (2) contains (A) brominated vegetable oil, (B)
- 5 potassium bromate, (C) propylparaben, or (D) red dye number three.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the manufacture, distribution, delivery or sale of foods containing certain additives.
