**AN ACT PROHIBITING PROOF OF VACCINATION REQUIREMENTS
OR INQUIRIES TO GAIN PUBLIC ACCESS TO COMMERCIAL
ESTABLISHMENTS OR STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT LANDS OR
BUILDINGS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit (1) businesses and
- 2 other commercial establishments held open to the public from requiring
- 3 proof of vaccination or inquiring into the vaccination records of
- 4 customers or vendors, and (2) public officials from requiring proof of
- 5 vaccination or inquiring into the vaccination records for the use of state
- 6 or municipal lands or buildings.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit proof of vaccination requirements or inquiring into vaccine records to gain public access to commercial establishments or state or local government lands or buildings.
