"AN ACT ALLOWING BOARD MEMBERS OF QUASI-PUBLIC AGENCIES TO OBTAIN HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE UNDER THE STATE EMPLOYEE PLAN."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2025*) Notwithstanding any
4 provision of the general statutes, no member of the General Assembly
5 shall, during the term for which such member is elected, be appointed
6 by the Governor, the General Assembly or any other appointing
7 authority of this state to serve on the board of any quasi-public agency.
8 For the purposes of this section, "quasi-public agency" has the same
9 meaning as provided in section 1-120 of the general statutes."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
